POINTS SYSTEM

TRI STATE YOUTH RODEO ASSOCIATION WILL BE USING A POINT SYSTEM. STANDINGS ARE DETERMINED ON THE POINT SYSTEM AND NOT BY MONEY WON.

FIRST PLACE	100 POINTS
SECOND PLACE	90 POINTS
THIRD PLACE	80 POINTS
FOURTH PLACE	70 POINTS
FIFTH PLACE	60 POINTS
SIXTH PLACE	50 POINTS
SEVENTH PLACE	40 POINTS
EIGHTH PLACE	30 POINTS
NINETH PLACE	20 POINTS
TENTH PLACE	10 POINTS

PAYOFF SCALE IS DETERMINED BY THE AMOUNT OF CONTESTANTS IN THAT EVENT. SIX PLACES IS THE MAXIMUM OF THE PAYOFF SCALE, BUT THE POINT SYSTEM WILL AWARD POINTS UP TO TENTH PLACE.

WE AS AN ASSOCIATION WANT OUR MEMBERS TO EXPERIENCE AND ENJOY THE SPORT OF RODEO WHILE LEARNING RESPONSIBILITY, RESPECT, CONFIDENCE AND DISCIPLINE. THE FOLLOWING RULES ARE FOR THE SAFETY AND WELL BEING OF OUR MEMBERS, ANIMALS AND OTHERS.

CHANGES OR ADDITIONS NOTED IN RED

GENERAL RULES

1. DECISION OF JUDGES WILL BE FINAL.

ANY CONTESTANT, PARENT/GUARDIAN ARGUING WITH A JUDGE, OFFICIAL, WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND WILL RESULT IN A \$50 FINE!!

IF ANY JUDGE SEES A SAFETY ISSUE HE CAN DROP THE FLAG AND NO RE-RUN WILL BE ISSUED.

IF A CONTESTANT HAS A QUESTION CONCERNING A RULE OR HAPPENINGS IN THEIR EVENT THEY MUST CONSULT WITH THE DIRECTOR OF ARENA IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE EVENT. **NOT DURING THE EVENT.** THE ARENA DIRECTOR WILL CONSULT WITH JUDGE. IF THE JUDGE AGREES THAT AN ERRONEOUS RULING WAS MADE AND THAT ERROR IS CORRECTABLE; THEN THE JUDGE SHALL MODIFY THE RULING ACCORDINGLY. OTHERWISE; THE DECISION SHALL STAND. **ONLY THE CONTESTANT HAS THE RIGHT TO QUESTION A RULE OR TO PROTEST A DECISION.** **THE DIRECTOR OR JUDGE WILL NOT LOOK AT VIDEO CAMERAS UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.**

2. EACH MEMBER MUST SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP WITH THE PARENTAL CONSENT, WAIVER OF LIABILITY SIGNED AND NOTARIZED, A COPY OF THE APPLICANT'S BIRTH CERTIFICATE MUST BE RECEIVED WITH APPLICATION, AND THE RULE/MEDICAL RELEASE VERIFICATION FORM .

3. MEMBERSHIP INCLUDES ADMISSION TO RODEO FOR CONTESTANT ONLY! MEMBER WILL RECEIVE A MEMBERSHIP CARD, A RULE BOOK AND A CALENDAR OF RODEO EVENTS. IF A MEMBER HAS TO HAVE ANY OF THESE ITEMS REPLACED THERE WILL BE A \$5.00 CHARGE PER ITEM.

4. PEE WEE ENTRY FEES PER EVENT \$15.00: (\$12.00 TO PAYOFF/ \$3.00 TO ASSOCIATION.

JUNIOR ENTRY FEES PER EVENT \$20.00:(\$15.00 TO PAYOFF/ \$5.00 TO ASSOCIATION.

JACKPOT ENTRY FEES PER EVENT \$25.00:(\$17.00 TO PAYOFF/ \$8.00 TO ASSOCIATION.

5. ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID NO LATER THAN 1 HOUR BEFORE THE START OF THE RODEO. FAILURE TO PAY WITHIN THIS TIME FRAME COULD RESULT OF A FINE OF \$2.00 TO BE PAID TO THE RODEO SECRETARY. **ALL ENTRY FEES ARE TO BE PAID IN EXACT CHANGE. CASH ONLY - NO CHECKS.**

6. CONTESTANT AND CONTESTANTS ANIMAL MAY TURN OUT DUE TO VISIBLE INJURY, OR ILLNESS IF APPROVED BY ONE OF THE RODEO JUDGES. CONTESTANTS WITH DOCTORS RELEASE OR VET RELEASE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR FEES OR TURN OUT FINES PROVIDING THEY FURNISH THE RODEO DIRECTORS WITH THE RELEASE WITHIN 7 DAYS OF THE RODEO. OTHERWISE, CONTESTANT WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING FEES AND FINES BEFORE COMPETING IN ANOTHER RODEO.

7. ALL CONTESTANTS AND PARENTS ARE EXPECTED TO USE PROPER AND SPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT. ABSOLUTLY NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND/OR ILLEGAL DRUGS ALLOWED ON ANY RODEO GROUNDS ! A MEMBER

WILL HAVE POINTS DEDUCTED, FINED OR SUSPENDED; A PARENT/GUARDIAN WILL BE FINED OR SUSPENDED FOR CONDUCT OR SPEECH THAT IS DETRIMENTAL TO THE BEST INTEREST OF THE TRI STATE YOUTH RODEO ASSOCIATION.

A MEMBER WHO IS NOT ABIDING BY THE RULES WILL HAVE POINTS DEDUCTED; 1ST OFFENSE - 10 POINTS 2ND OFFENSE - 20 POINTS; 3RD OFFENSE - SUSPENDED.

IF THE MEMBER DOES NOT HAVE POINTS THEN THE MEMBER WILL BE

FINED;

1ST OFFENSE \$20.00; 2ND OFFENSE \$40.00; 3RD OFFENSE – SUSPENDED.

IF JUDGE, REPRESENTATIVES, OR OFFICIALS SEE FIT, THEY CAN DEDUCT AND FINE A MEMBER IF NEED TO DO SO.

A PARENT WHO IS NOT ABIDING BY THE RULES WILL BE FINED;

1ST OFFENSE \$20.00; 2ND OFFENSE \$40.00; 3RD OFFENSE – SUSPENDED.

JUDGES AND ANY OF THE TRI STATE REPRESENTATIVES HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO FINE A MEMBER OR PARENT/GUARDIAN FOR INFRACTIONS OF ANY OF THE ASSOCIATIONS RULES. POINTS ARE DEDUCTED IMMEDIATELY, FINES MUST BE PAID BEFORE MEMBER CAN COMPETE IN ANOTHER RODEO.

8. DRAW OUTS AND NO-SHOWS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ENTRY FEES AND

\$10.00 TURN-OUT FINE FOR EACH EVENT INVOLVED IN THE TURN-OUT

UNLESS CONTESTANT HAS A WRITTEN DOCTORS RELEASE OR VET EXCUSE.

9. PERMIT WILL BE ALLOWED AT A FEE OF \$10.00 PER RODEO PLUS ENTRY FEES.

SAME REQUIREMENTS FOR PERMIT CONTESTANTS AS FOR MEMBERS. PERMIT CONTESTANTS CANNOT EARN POINTS BUT CAN WIN MONEY. \$10 PERMIT FEE GOES TO THE ASSOCIATION NOT IN PAYOFF.

10. RE-RIDES IN CALF, JUNIOR AND JACKPOT BULL RIDING, BAREBACK WILL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE JUDGE. NO RE-RIDES WILL BE GIVEN IN MUTTON BUSTIN: EXCEPTION (EXPLAINED IN MUTTON BUSTIN EVENT RULES)

11. PARENT/GUARDIAN CANNOT ENTER INTO ARENA AND CORRECT CHILD OR SPEAK TO CHILD IN A DEROGATORY MANNER.

12. ALL CLOTHING MUST BE WESTERN ATTIRE. CONTESTANTS MUST WEAR A COWBOY HAT AND LONG SLEEVE SHIRT WITH CUFFS, REGULAR OR BANDED COLLAR AND WESTERN BOOTS WHILE IN ARENA. WESTERN CARPENTER JEANS ARE ALLOWED AS LONG AS THEY ARE NOT SAGGING.

JEANS WITH LARGE HOLES WILL NOT BE EXCEPTED. SHIRT TAILS ARE TO BE TUCKED IN. NO TENNIS SHOES. **ANYONE WHO ENTERS ARENA IS TO BE IN DRESS CODE.**

THE DRESS CODE WILL BE IN EFFECT ONE HOUR PRIOR TO PERFORMANCES.

MEMBERS ARE TO STAY IN DRESS CODE DURING THE ENTIRE RODEO.

DRESS CODE ON VERY HOT DAYS WILL BE AT DIRECTORS DISCRETION.

13. GRAND ENTRY – CONTESTANTS COMPETING IN RODEO WITH A HORSE

MUST BE PREPARED TO RIDE IN THE GRAND ENTRY. NO DOUBLING !

14. CALL-INS & EMAIL CALL-INS WILL BE ON MONDAY – WEEK PRIOR TO RODEO UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. EMAIL CALL-INS (PLEASE GET INFORMATION FROM DIRECTOR IF NEEDED ON EMAILING CALL-INS) CALL-INS ARE BETWEEN 7:00PM – 10:00PM.

LATE CALL-INS WILL BE CHARGED A LATE CALL-IN FEE OF \$15.00. THIS IS PER DAY NOT PER EVENT. ABSOLUTELY NO CALL-INS AFTER FRIDAY OF THE CALL-IN WEEK.

NO WALK-UPS !!

15. CONTESTANT MUST CALL IN NO MORE THAN 4 CONTESTANTS PER EVENT PER PHONE CALL. CONTESTANT MAY DRAW OUT DURING CALL IN. DRAW OUTS AFTER CALL INS AND NO

SHOWS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR FEES AND TURN OUT FINE WHICH MUST BE PAID BEFORE COMPETING IN ANOTHER RODEO.

16. THE JUDGE AT ANY APPROVED RODEO MAY DISQUALIFY ANY CONTESTANT FOR NOT BEING READY TO COMPETE WITHIN A REASONABLE TIME AFTER BEING CALLED TO COMPETE. CONTESTANT MUST BE READY TO COMPETE WHEN YOUR EVENT IS CALLED, THERE WILL BE A TWO MINUTE RULE IN EFFECT WHEN YOUR NAME IS CALLED. WHEN IT IS YOUR TIME TO COMPETE THE ARENA TIMER WILL BE TIMING EACH CONTESTANT. IF YOU DO NOT MAKE THE TWO MINUTE TIME LIMIT YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
17. A MEMBER **MUST** HAVE COMPETED IN **AT LEAST 6 INDIVIDUAL RODEOS** TO BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE IN THE FINALS. **THE EVENTS YOU COMPETE IN AT THE FINALS YOU MUST HAVE COMPETED IN THOSE EVENTS IN ATLEAST 6 RODEOS. IT IS MANDATORY FOR YOU TO COMPETE IN THE FINALS IF YOU ARE ELIGIBLE. IF YOU DO NOT COMPETE AND YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE ANY AWARDS AT THE BANQUET YOU WILL FORFEIT YOUR AWARD OR AWARDS AND YOUR POSITION IN THE SEASON POINT STANDINGS. IT IS MANDATORY TO COMPETE IN ALL 3 DAYS OF THE FINALS UNLESS YOU HAVE A VET OR DOCTOR'S EXCUSE. YOU ARE REQUIRED TO NOTIFY THE DIRECTOR.**
18. MEMBERS ARE ADVISED TO KEEP UP WITH THEIR OWN POINTS. ANY DISCREPENCIES SHOULD BE REPORTED TO THE RODEO SECRETARY AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, NO LATER THAN 4 WEEKS BEFORE RODEO FINALS.
19. AN UP TO DATE NEGATIVE COGGINS IS REQUIRED ON HORSES ENTERING IN THE RODEO EVENTS. **THESE WILL BE CHECKED**, SO MAKE SURE YOUR COGGINS IS UP TO DATE. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
20. **EXHIBITION RIDES ARE TO BE CALLED IN ON REGULAR CALL-IN NIGHT. CHANGES MADE ON DAY OF RODEO OR WALKUPS ARE AT DIRECTORS/SECRETARIES DISCRETION. EXHIBITION FEE IS \$10 FOR BARRELS AND POLES. EVENTS THAT INVOLVE STOCK EXHIBITION FEE IS THE SAME AS THE ENTRY FEE IN THAT DIVISION.. THESE FEES DOES NOT GO INTO PAYOFFS.** A WAIVER OF LIABILITY FORM MUST BE SIGNED BY PARENT/GUARDIAN AND PARTICIPANT. YOU RECEIVE NO POINTS OR WINNINGS IN EXHIBITION.
21. CONTESTANT IS RESPONSIBLE TO KNOW WHICH HEAD OF LIVESTOCK THEY HAVE DRAWN. COMPETING ON WRONG HEAD OF LIVESTOCK WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION OR NO TIME.
22. IN ROUGH STOCK EVENTS IN CASE OF ANIMAL FOULING HIMSELF OR CONTESTANT, CONTESTANT MUST DECLARE HIMSELF WITHIN 2 JUMPS BY DOUBLE GRABBING OR NO RE-RIDE WILL BE GIVEN. FOULING WILL BE DETERMINED BY JUDGE.
23. A HORSE REARING OR UNRULY WHO IS A DANGER TO RIDER, OTHER PEOPLE, ANIMALS OR PROPERTY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FOR SAFETY REASONS. ANY UNLAWFUL ABUSE TO ANIMALS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND WILL RESULT IN A FINE.
24. ABSOLUTLY NO LOITERING IN ARENA AFTER CONTESTANT HAS COMPETED IN THEIR EVENT. ALSO THERE IS TO BE NO ONE OTHER THAN RODEO STAFF AND CONTESTANTS AT BACK PENS.
25. ALL RODEO GROUNDS ARE TO BE KEPT CLEAN. ANY MEMBER OR PARENT WHO CAMPS AT THE RODEO GROUNDS WHERE AVAILABLE MUST KEEP CAMPSITE CLEAN. AT EVERY RODEO MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO PICKUP TRASH. **NO PAYOUTS WILL BE GIVEN UNTIL GROUNDS ARE CLEAN! GROUNDS WILL BE INSPECTED BEFORE PAYOUTS ARE GIVEN OUT.**

26. POINTS WILL START TABULATING AT FIRST SANCTIONED RODEO OF THE SEASON.
27. TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE ALL AROUND IN PEEWEE, JUNIOR OR JACKPOT YOU MUST COMPETE IN 2 OR MORE EVENTS AND COMPETE IN AT **LEAST 6 RODEOS IN THAT EVENT AND PLACE IN TWO OR MORE EVENTS.** (MEANING 1- 10TH PLACE). YOUR ALL AROUND POINTS WILL NOT BE POSTED UNTIL YOU HAVE COMPETED IN 6 RODEOS. THE RODEO SECRETARY WILL NOT POST ALL AROUND POINTS UNTIL AFTER THE 6TH RODEO.
28. IF A CONTESTANT MOVES UP OR DOWN IN A DIVISION THEY WILL FORFEIT THEIR EVENT POINTS BUT THEY WILL KEEP THEIR PARTICIPATION POINTS. FOR EXAMPLE IF A CHILD IS COMPETING IN MUTTON BUSTIN AND DECIDES TO MOVE UP TO CALF RIDING THEN EVENT POINTS EARNED IN MUTTON BUSTIN WILL BE FORFEITED.
29. IN ALL ROUGH STOCK RIDING EVENTS (BAREBACK, BULL RIDING, JUNIOR BULL RIDING, CALF RIDING AND MUTTON BUSTIN) CONTESTANT CANNOT STRAP OR TIE HIM OR HERSELF TO THE ANIMAL TO PREVENT BEING BUCKED OFF. A BUTTERFLY, REGULAR WRAP OR SPLIT FINGER WRAP IS ALLOWED. ANY CONTESTANT WITH HOMEMADE ROSIN CAUGHT USING OR ON THEIR PROPERTY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND SUSPENDED.
30. ALL ROUGH STOCK EVENT CONTESTANTS OR PARENTS CANNOT USE ANY KIND OF DEVICES ON THE ANIMAL TO MAKE THE ANIMAL BUCK, IF ANY DEVICES ARE USED IT WILL BE AT STOCK CONTRACTORS DISCRETION.

JUNIOR BAREBACK:

(RULES ARE THE SAME AS JACKPOT BAREBACK EXCEPT THE HORSE MUST BE RIDDEN FOR 6 SECONDS)

CALF ROPING:

1. CONTESTANT MUST ROPE CALF, DISMOUNT, GO DOWN THE ROPE, THROW THE CALF BY HAND AND CROSS AND TIE ANY THREE LEGS.

5. TIE MUST HOLD FOR 5 SECONDS WITH THE TIME TO START WHEN THE ROPER HAS REMOUNTED HIS HORSE AND STEPPED FORWARD TO ALLOW SLACK IN THE ROPE. THE FLAG JUDGE WILL STOP THE WATCH IF CALF KICKS FREE. IF ELAPSED TIME IS LESS THAN 5 SECONDS, THE CONTESTANT WILL RECEIVE NO TIME

- 6 TWO LOOPS ARE PERMITTED. ROPER MUST CARRY TWO ROPES. FIRST LOOP CANNOT BE REBUILT.
7. LOOP MUST BE RELEASED FROM HAND TO BE A LEGAL CATCH. THE HORSE MUST CLEAR THE BOX BEFORE A LOOP IS THROWN.
8. A CONTESTANT MAY NOT ENTER THE CALF ROPING AND THE BREAKAWAY ROPING.
9. TOTAL 60 SECOND TIME LIMIT.
10. IF THE CALF ESCAPES THE ARENA, FLAG IS DROPPED AND CONTESTANT GETS ANIMAL BACK, LAP AND TAP, WITH THE TIME ADDED WHEN THE FLAG WAS DROPPED.
11. CONTESTANT CANNOT RECEIVE ANY ASSISTANCE AFTER CROSSING STARTING LINE.
12. ROPER WILL BE FLAGGED NO TIME FOR TOUCHING CALF, OR STRING OR BY TOUCHING ROPE TO TRAIN HIS HORSE AFTER GIVING FINISH SIGNAL, OR BY DRAGGING CALF AFTER HE REMOUNTS HORSE.
13. IF CONTESTANT AT ANYTIME IS IN DANGER THE ROPING STAFF WILL ASSIST.
14. THE CONTESTANT CAN HAVE A HELPER PUSHING THEIR CALF, BUT ONCE IT IS PUSHED THE HELPER IS NOT TO GO INTO THE ARENA.

PEE WEE & JUNIOR BREAKAWAY ROPING:
(BOYS & GIRLS)

6. TIME WILL STOP WHEN FLAG PULLS AWAY FROM THE SADDLE HORN.
CONTESTANT CANNOT JERK ROPE LOOSE FROM THE SADDLE HORN.
7. ONLY 1 LOOP IS ALLOWED.
8. A CONTESTANT MAY NOT ENTER BREAKAWAY ROPING AND CALF ROPING.
9. **12 X 12 WHITE FLAGS(HANKERCHIEF) ARE TO BE USED. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
10. THE LOOP MUST BE RELEASED FROM HAND TO BE A LEGAL CATCH. THE HORSE MUST CLEAR THE BOX BEFORE A LOOP IS THROWN.

JACKPOT GIRLS BREAKAWAY ROPING:

GIRL'S BREAKAWAY ROPING WILL FOLLOW THE SAME RULES AS THE JUNIOR BREAKAWAY ROPING WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTION GIRL'S BREAKAWAY ROPING IS AGE 14 – 18 YEARS OLD.

POLE BENDING (PEEWEE – JUNIOR – JACKPOT):

(PEEWEE – BOYS & GIRLS JUNIOR & JACKPOT – GIRLS ONLY)

POLE PATTERN ON PAGE 24

1. POLE BENDING WILL CONSIST OF 6 POLES PLACED 21 FEET APART. POSITION OF STARTING AND FINISH LINE AND POLES WILL REMAIN THE SAME DURING THE EVENT.
2. TIME WILL START WHEN THE HORSE'S NOSE CROSSES THE STARTING LINE.
3. CONTESTANT OR HORSE MAY TOUCH POLE, BUT IF THE POLE FALLS DOWN, THERE WILL BE A 5 SECOND PENALTY FOR EACH FALLEN POLE.
4. RUN WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:
 - A. PASS ALL POLES ON EITHER SIDE.
 - B. WEAVE THROUGH ALL POLES BEGINNING WITH POLE AT THE OPPOSITE END OF STARTING LINE.
 - C. TURN THE LAST POLE AND WEAVE BACK THROUGH ALL POLES.
 - D. TURN THE LAST POLE AND CROSS THE FINISH LINE.
5. THE FOLLOWING WILL RESULT IN A **DISQUALIFICATION:**
 - A. HORSE RECROSSING STARTING LINE BEFORE COMPLETING PATTERN.

B. BREAKING PATTERN.

Not following the pole bending pattern will receive a no time. A broken pattern shall be defined as breaking their forward motion to retrace their tracks to finish the pattern and/or passing the plane of the pole on the off side. Example: Should a contestant run by a pole and have to back up or turn around and retrace their tracks, this would be considered a broken pattern. Also, if a pole is knocked down and the contestant does not follow the weave pattern around the original base position of the fallen pole, it is considered a broken pattern.

D. INTENTIONAL FLIPPING OF YOUR HAT.

5. TEAM ROPING HEADER MUST ROPE AS HEADER AND HEELER AS HEELER AS CALLED IN OR WILL BE DISQUALIFIED. NO SWITCHING UP IN THE MIDDLE.

6. ROPING STEER WITHOUT TURNING LOOSE OF THE LOOP WILL RESULT IN A NO TIME.
7. IF STEER ESCAPES THE ARENA, FLAG IS DROPPED AND CONTESTANTS GET THE ANIMAL BACK, LAP AND TAP, WITH THE TIME ADDED WHEN THE FLAG WAS DROPPED.
8. MISTAKE BY THE FLAGMAN WILL RESULT IN A RERUN.
9. HEELER CANNOT DELIVER HIS LOOP UNTIL THE BODY OF THE STEER HAS BEEN TURNED BY HEADER.
10. CONTESTANT MUST HOLD DALLIES UNTIL FLAGMAN PASSES THE CATCHES.
11. TIME WILL BE TAKEN WHEN STEER IS ROPED AT BOTH ENDS, BOTH HORSES FACING STEER IN LINE WITH ROPES DALLIED TIGHT, HORSE'S FRONT FEET MUST BE ON THE GROUND WITH NO OBSTRUCTION.
12. TOTAL 60 SECOND TIME LIMIT.
13. TIME WILL BE TAKEN WHEN STEER IS ROPED AT BOTH ENDS, HORSES ARE ON ALL FOURS AND HORSES FACING STEER IN "L" OR BETTER WITH ROPES TIGHT AND DALLIED.
14. THERE WILL BE A 5 SECOND PENALTY FOR ROPING ONLY ONE HEEL.
15. RE-RUN WILL NOT BE GIVEN DUE TO HANGING A HORN OR HORNS IN THE CHUTE.
16. THE FOLLOWING WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION:
 - A. ANIMAL NOT BEING ON FEET WHEN ROPED BY HEADER OR HEELER.

CHUTE DOGGIN: (JACKPOT)

CHUTE DOGGIN: (JUNIOR)

SAME RULES APPLY AS JACKPOT CHUTE DOGGIN EXCEPT:

1. ALL JUNIOR CHUTE DOGGIN STEERS WILL BE TAILED.

GOAT DOGGIN: (PEEWEE)
(BOYS & GIRLS)

1. GOAT WILL BE ON A 6 FOOT LINE AND STAKED IN THE ARENA.

 - E. HAT COMES OFF BEFORE ENTERING ALLEYWAY. ALLEYWAY IS PART OF THE ARENA.
 - F. INTENTIONAL FLIPPING OF YOUR HAT.

IF THE CONTESTANT TURNS 9 YEARS OLD BEFORE MARCH 1ST OF THE CURRENT YEAR THEN THAT CONTESTANT'S POINTS WILL GO IN THE JUNIOR DIVISION. BUT THERE WILL BE ONLY ONE CALF RIDING CHAMPION BUCKLE GIVEN AT THE BANQUET.
7. ANY CONTESTANT WITH HOMEMADE ROSIN CAUGHT USING OR ON THEIR PROPERTY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND SUSPENDED.

PEEWEE CALF RIDING:

SAME RULES APPLY AS JUNIOR CALF RIDING EXCEPT PEEWEE CALF RIDING IS AGE 8 & UNDER

**MUTTON BUSTIN:
(PEEWEE – BOYS & GIRLS)**

1. MUST NOT EXCEED 7 YEARS OF AGE NOR EXCEED 50 POUNDS.
2. **THERE WILL BE A 5 FT LINE DRAWN IN FRONT OF BUCKING CHUTES; IF SHEEP DOES NOT CROSS THAT LINE CONTESTANT RECEIVES A RERIDE.**
3. THE FOLLOWING RULES APPLY:
 - A. IF RIDER IS 7 YEARS OF AGE OR YOUNGER, THEY CANNOT ENTER CALF RIDING AND THEN RETURN TO MUTTON BUSTIN.
 - B. IF CONTESTANT STARTS WITH ONE HAND THEY MUST CONTINUE RIDING WITH ONE HAND. THEY CANNOT TOUCH ROPE, SHEEP OR THEMSELVES WITH FREE HAND IF CONTESTANT TOUCHES THEY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**
 - C. IF CONTESTANT USES 2 HANDS 5 POINTS WILL BE DEDUCTED FROM TOTAL SCORE.**
 - C. ONLY ONE PERSON IS ALLOWED TO HELP CONTESTANT AT CHUTES. NO ONE IS ALLOWED IN THE ARENA EXCEPT THE RODEO STAFF. NO WAITING IN THE ARENA AFTER THE CONTESTANT HAS PARTICIPATED.(DUE TO SAFETY OF CONTESTANTS)
4. MOUTH PIECE IS MANDATORY!
5. ANY CONTESTANT WITH HOMEMADE ROSIN CAUGHT USING OR ON THEIR PROPERTY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND SUSPENDED.
6. **NO RE-RIDES UNLESS SHEEP GOES DOWN IN FORWARD MOTION AND CONTESTANT GOES OVER THE SHEEP'S HEAD OR SHEEP DOES NOT CROSS 5 FOOT LINE.**
NO RE-RIDE WILL BE GIVEN IF SHEEP FALLS SIDE TO SIDE OR SHEEP DOES NOT PERFORM.

**GOAT TYING: (JUNIOR & JACKPOT)
(JUNIOR & JACKPOT – GIRLS ONLY)**

1. TIME WILL BEGIN WHEN CONTESTANT CROSSES STARTING LINE AND WILL STOP WHEN TIE IS COMPLETE.
2. NO BILLY GOATS WILL BE USED.
3. POSITIONS WILL BE DRAWN. IF CONTESTANTS ARE RIDING THE SAME HORSE, THEY SHOULD NOTIFY THE SECRETARY DURING CALL IN.
4. CONTESTANT MUST THROW GOAT BY HAND AND CROSS AND TIE THREE LEGS. NO WIRE WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE STRING.

5. IF GOAT IS DOWN WHEN CONTESTANT REACHES IT, SHE MUST RE-THROW THE GOAT. IF THE CONTESTANT'S HAND IS ON THE GOAT WHEN IT GOES DOWN, IT IS CONSIDERED THROWN.
6. GOAT MUST REMAIN TIED FOR 5 SECONDS. THIS TIME WILL NOT BEGIN UNTIL THE CONTESTANT HAS STEPPED BACK FROM THE GOAT. JUDGES DISCRETION WILL BE USED IF THE CONTESTANT IS CAUGHT IN THE ROPE OR UNDER THE GOAT.
7. CONTESTANT MAY NOT TOUCH THE GOAT OR TIE IN ANY WAY AFTER SHE HAS SIGNALLED THAT HER TIE IS COMPLETE.
8. IF THE HORSE CROSSES OVER THE ROPE, TOUCHES THE ROPE OR THE GOAT THE CONTESTANT WILL RECEIVE A 10 SECOND PENALTY.
9. IF CONTESTANT SLAMS GOAT MALICIOUSLY, CONTESTANT WILL BE WARNED THE FIRST TIME. 2ND TIME WILL RESULT IN A FINE.
10. STRING CANNOT HAVE LOOP MADE/TIED IN IT BEFORE ENTERING ARENA.
11. NO INTENTIONAL FLIPPING OF HATS!
12. TOTAL 60 SECOND TIME LIMIT

PEE WEE GOAT TYING:
(BOYS & GIRLS)

THE SAME GOAT TYING RULES APPLY EXCEPT FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- A. GOAT WILL ALREADY BE THROWN AND HELD DOWN WITH THREE LEGS CROSSED.
- B. POSITION OF THE GOAT ON GROUND WILL DEPEND ON WHETHER THE CONTESTANT TYING THE GOAT IS RIGHT OR LEFT HANDED.
- C. IF THE GOAT IS TO BE TIED LEFT HANDED, CONTESTANT WILL NOTIFY ARENA DIRECTOR BEFORE RUN SO GOAT WILL BE SWITCHED TO THE CORRECT POSITION.

JUNIOR BULL RIDING:

1. AGE LIMIT IS 11YRS - 13 YRS OLD AS OF MARCH 1ST OF THE RODEO YEAR.
2. CONTESTANT MUST RIDE 6 SECONDS.
3. CONTESTANT MUST NOT TOUCH STEER WITH FREE HAND.
4. VEST & MOUTHPIECE IS MANDATORY! HELMET IS OPTIONAL BUT SUGGESTED.
5. ANY CONTESTANT WITH HOMEMADE ROSIN CAUGHT USING OR ON THEIR PROPERTY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND SUSPENDED.

BULL RIDING:

1. RIDING IS TO BE DONE WITH ONE HAND IN A LOOSE ROPE WITH OR WITHOUT HAND HOLD. KNOTS OR HITCHES DESIGNED TO PREVENT ROPE FROM FALLING OFF WILL NOT BE ALLOWED. HOOKS OR RINGS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE ROPE.
2. ALL ROPES MUST HAVE A BELL OR NO MARKING WILL BE GIVEN.
3. IF A RIDER MAKES A QUALIFIED RIDE WITH ANY PART OF THE BULL ROPE IN HIS HAND, HE WILL RECEIVE A MARKING.
4. A CONTESTANT MAY RECEIVE A RE-RIDE AT THE DISCRETION OF A JUDGE.
5. CONTESTANT CANNOT TOUCH ANIMAL WITH THE FREE HAND.
6. CONTESTANT MUST RIDE 8 SECONDS. TIME WILL START WHEN THE BULL BREAKS THE PLAIN OF CHUTE.
7. DRY ROSIN MAY BE USED ON THE GLOVE OR ROPE. ANY CONTESTANT WITH HOMEMADE ROSIN CAUGHT USING OR ON THEIR PROPERTY WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND SUSPENDED.
8. IN ROUGH STOCK EVENTS, IN CASE OF ANIMAL FOULING HIMSELF OR CONTESTANT, CONTESTANT MUST DECLAIR HIMSELF WITHIN 2 JUMPS BY DOUBLE GRABBING THE BULL OR NO RE-RIDE WILL BE GIVEN. FOULING WILL BE DETERMINED BY JUDGE.
9. VEST AND MOUTH PIECE IS MANDATORY! HELMET IS OPTIONAL BUT SUGGESTED.

COWBOY GOAT TYING:

(THIS EVENT IS TO PREPARE OUR JUNIOR BOYS FOR JACKPOT CALF ROPING)

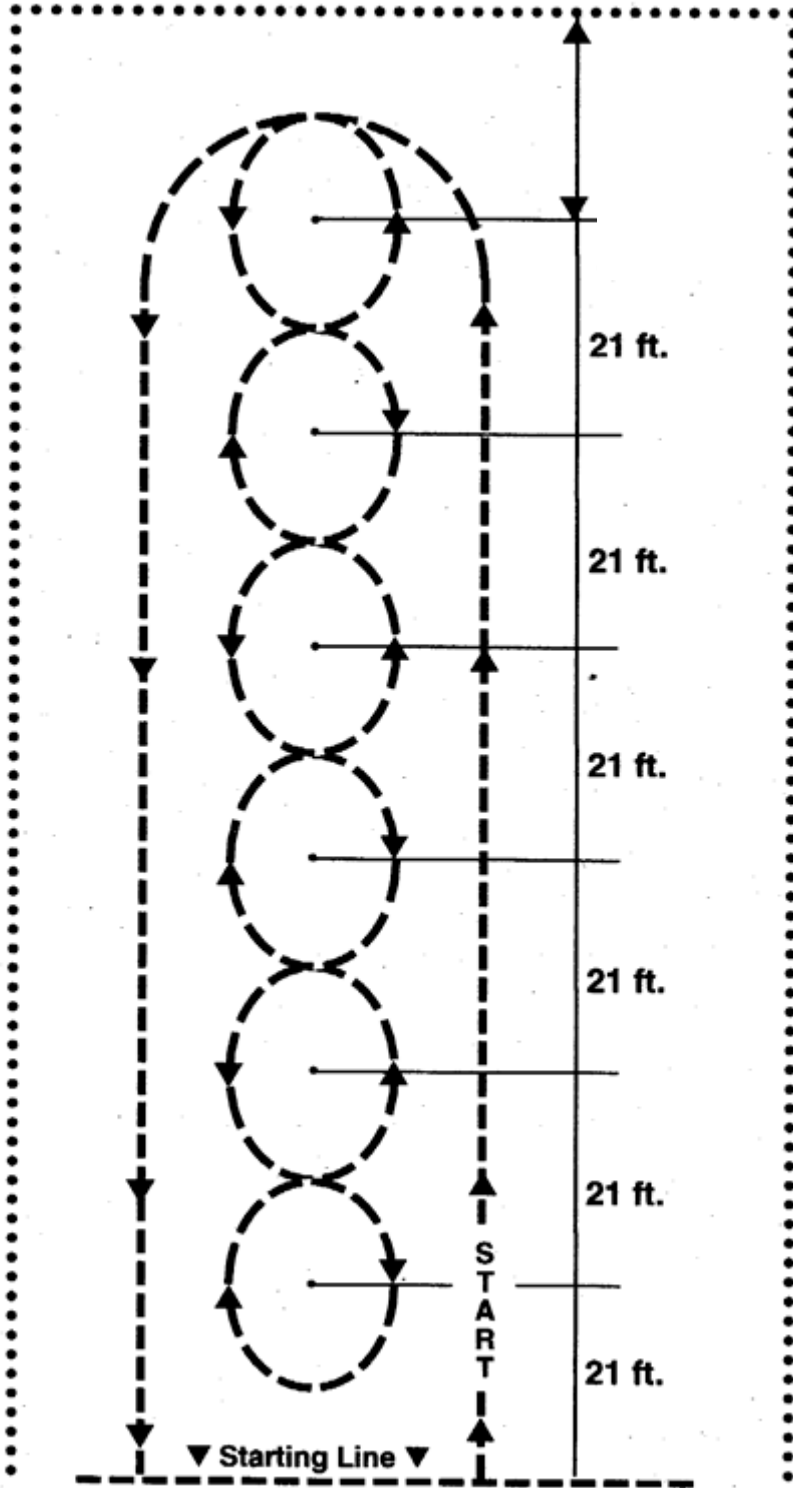
1. TIME WILL BEGIN WHEN CONTESTANT CROSSES STARTING LINE AND WILL STOP WHEN TIE IS COMPLETE.
2. THE GOAT WILL BE STAKED IN THE ARENA.
3. CONTESTANT MUST THROW GOAT BY HAND AND CROSS AND TIE THREE LEGS. NO WIRE WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE STRING.
4. IF GOAT IS DOWN WHEN CONTESTANT REACHES IT, HE MUST RE-THROW THE GOAT. IF THE CONTESTANT'S HAND IS ON THE GOAT WHEN IT GOES DOWN, IT IS CONSIDERED THROWN.

5. GOAT MUST REMAIN TIED FOR 5 SECONDS. THIS TIME WILL NOT BEGIN UNTIL THE CONTESTANT HAS STEPPED BACK FROM THE GOAT. JUDGES DISCRETION WILL BE USED IF THE CONTESTANT IS CAUGHT IN THE ROPE OR UNDER THE GOAT.
6. CONTESTANT MAY NOT TOUCH THE GOAT OR TIE IN ANY WAY AFTER HE HAS SIGNALLED THAT HIS TIE IS COMPLETE.
7. IF THE HORSE CROSSES OVER THE ROPE, TOUCHES THE ROPE OR THE GOAT THE CONTESTANT WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
8. IF CONTESTANT SLAMS GOAT MALICIOUSLY, CONTESTANT WILL BE WARNED THE FIRST TIME. 2ND TIME WILL RESULT IN A FINE.
9. TOTAL 60 SECOND TIME LIMIT.
10. PIGGING STRING MUST BE USED.

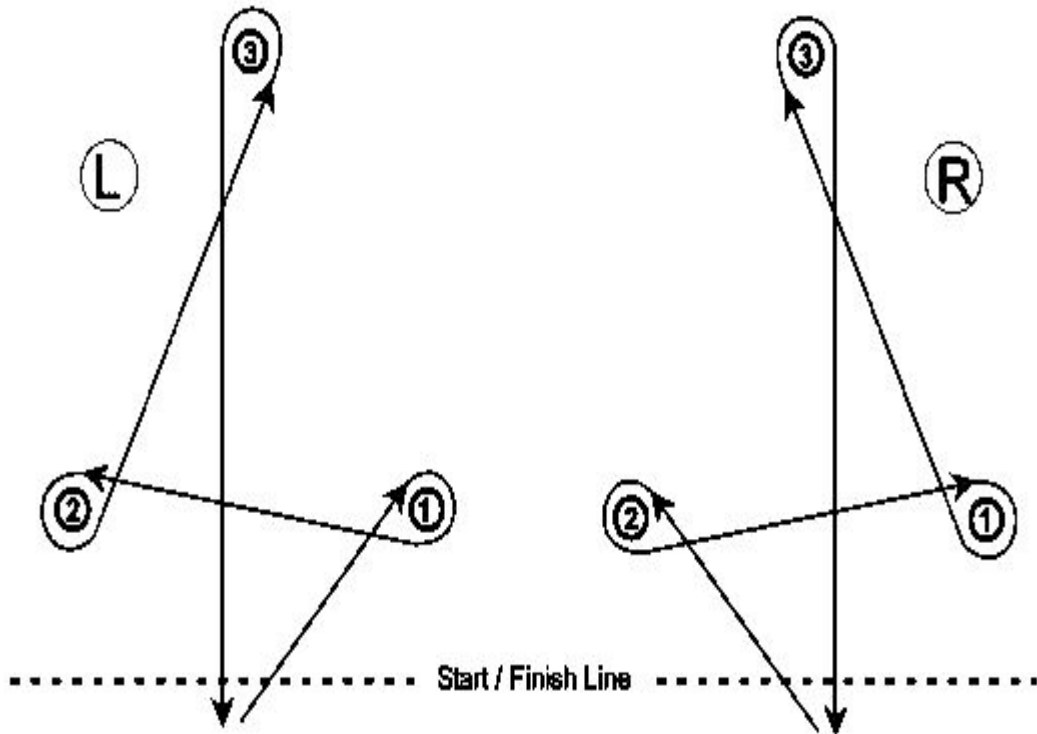
